

Famo Feeds – Freeport, MN (1903 – 2009)

Famo Feeds, originally known as Freeport Roller Mills & founded in 1903, was built along a railroad line in downtown Freeport, MN. The business got started in the grain and flour business, but eventually moved into selling livestock & poultry feed.

In the 1960's, Famo Feeds were developed & manufacturing began. As the feed line grew, manufacturing of pet foods began. For approximately 15 years pet food manufacturing was part of the business but was eventually discontinued & animal nutrition & feed products became the focus.

Currently, Famo Feeds is located on 22 acres in the Freeport Industrial Park just south of Interstate 94. A newly constructed plant was built in 2004 on this site.



The Beste family, which has owned Famo Feeds for the last 30 years, continues to manufacture and market a complete line of livestock, poultry and companion animal feed for their customers.
