PRIMARY SERVICE- Includes parts A & B. Price dependent on (1) Elevator Capacity, (2) Number of Locations and (3) Number of Additional Business Lines.

PART A:

All written programs required by 29 CFR 1910.272-OSHA Grain Handling Standard-to include:

- Programs are updated as needed by NDGDA/MGFA Staff.

AND

Two complete OSHA-type walkthrough inspections of the facility which includes:

- Written report of facility inspection with suggestions of items that could ultimately lead to OSHA citations.
- Assistance in interpreting regulations and how they apply to your facility.

PART B:

Required annual Employee Training Program which includes:

Training done on-site at your facility including the following subjects:

- Grain Handling Standard
- Emergency Action Plan
- Hot Work Permit Program
- Bin Entry Program
- Housekeeping Program
- Preventive Maintenance Program
- Hazard Communication (Employee Right-to-Know)
- Confined Space Entry
- OSHA Recordkeeping,
- General Industry Standards that apply.
- Forklift program.
- Anhydrous Ammonia.
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Railcar Handling
- Motorized Equipment Operation

Upon completion of the walkthrough, management will be given a list of suggestions and items which will then be its responsibility to complete. This list will include items which could ultimately result in possible OSHA citations.
