The Minnesota Grain & Feed Association will be sponsoring a northern MN grain grading school this spring. This school is conducted in a very practical manner by licensed grain inspectors. The grain grading school will be held on **Thursday**, **May 2, 2024 at Shooting Star Casino**, **Mahnomen** (800-453-7827). The focus at this school will be on the grading of corn, soybeans and wheat. The school will begin at 9:00 AM and conclude by 3:00 PM (lunch included). Proper use of grading equipment will be demonstrated, and each participant will receive a participation certificate.

The cost for the school is \$95/person for MGFA member firms. The non-member charge is \$115/person. The cost includes training materials, training personnel time, breaks and lunch.
